



FAQs

How do we read 1000 books by Kindergarten?

It's easy!

1 book per day for 3 years = 1,095 10 books per week for 2 years = 1,040 3 books a day for 1 year = 1,095

Do we have to read only books from the library?

No! Any age-appropriate book will work. No matter where you get them from, or how many times you read them - they all count!

I have more than one child I read to. Can I count the same title for each child?

Of course you can!

If someone else reads to my child, will that still count?

Yes! Any book read to your child by someone else, including at library storytimes, daycare, older sibling, etc., counts.
